

Buckinghamshire County Ladies Golf Association CHARITY ECLECTIC TROPHY TERMS OF THE COMPETITION

- 1. The Charity chosen will be one with connections in Buckinghamshire and shall be the choice of the County Captain, with the approval of the Executive Committee, and shall be supported for at least two years to coincide with her term of office. 2. The competition shall be open to all members of clubs affiliated to the County Association. 3. An entry fee shall be paid, the amount and method of collection to be decided by the individual club. The competition shall run from 1st April to 15th September. All scores must be submitted 4. between these dates. 5. Entry shall be submission of any 18 hole score acceptable for handicap under WHS Rules of Handicapping. 6. Thereafter a minimum of four holes may be played. Scores may not be taken during the course of a match and may only be taken during singles play.
- 7. In the case of 9 hole courses, where a player is not playing a full round, she must stipulate beforehand whether she is playing from the 1st to the 9th, or from the 10th to the 18th.
- 8. In the event of a club having more than one course, and/or more than one set of tees rated for ladies, only one course and one set of tees shall be selected for the competition.
- 9. After the initial card, improvements at individual holes shall be signed by the marker, and entered on the eclectic score sheet, in accordance with the arrangements of each club.
- 10. Handicap Allowance is 50% of Course Handicap on 16th September. The best seven net scores shall be sent to the Competition Secretary in order that the winning club can be ascertained. A result form is provided.
- 11. A Trophy to be held for one year shall be presented to the club with the lowest aggregate score.
