



# Buckinghamshire County Ladies' Golf Association

## CHARITY ECLECTIC

### RULES

1. The Charity chosen will be one with connections in Buckinghamshire and shall be the choice of the County Captain, with the approval of the Executive Committee, and shall be supported for at least two years to coincide with her term of office.
2. The competition shall be open to all members of clubs affiliated to the County Association.
3. An entry fee shall be paid, the amount and method of collection to be decided by the individual club.
4. Entry shall be submission of any 18 hole competition card – the player signing the relevant book before playing.
5. Thereafter a minimum of four holes may be played.
6. In the case of 9 hole courses, where a player is not playing a full round, she must stipulate beforehand whether she is playing from the 1<sup>st</sup> to the 9<sup>th</sup>, or from the 10<sup>th</sup> to the 18<sup>th</sup>.
7. All scores must be returned from the L.G.U. tees, or in the event of the L.G.U. tees being out of play, from the temporary or winter tee in play on the day.
8. Scores may not be taken during the course of a match.
9. Scores may be taken only during singles play.
10. After the initial card, improvements at individual holes shall be signed by the marker, and entered on the eclectic score sheet, in accordance with the arrangements of each club.
11. In the event of a club having more than one course, only one shall be selected for the competition.
12. The competition shall run from a selected date in April to a selected date in September each year.
13. The best seven scores less  $\frac{1}{2}$  **playing** handicap shall be sent to the Competition Secretary (Leagues) in order that the winning club can be ascertained. A result form is provided.
14. A Trophy to be held for one year shall be presented to the club with the lowest aggregate score.
