TRANSPORTATION POLICY CONSENT FORM

This is the Consent Form referred to in the BCLGA Transportation Policy. This form must be completed and signed by any player, caddie or other third party granted permission to use a buggy.

Players, caddies or other parties who have been permitted use of a golf buggy must also agree to the following terms and conditions of use:

- (a) Any person operating a golf buggy must do so with the utmost courtesy, care and consideration for the safety and convenience of others and in accordance with any relevant golf buggy operating guidelines;
- (b) A golf buggy shall be for the sole use of the player and/or her caddie and her equipment. A member of the Committee may deem that for reason of age or disability a third party is required to drive the golf buggy;
- (c) If a player has been granted permission to use a golf buggy, her caddie is allowed to use the buggy. If a player's caddie has been granted permission to use a buggy, the player is not allowed to use the buggy unless she has also been granted permission to use a buggy;
- (d) A golf buggy must not impede or interfere with normal pedestrians or vehicular traffic flow on roadways, ramps and pavements;
- (e) A player who has been granted permission to use a golf buggy (or any caddie or other third party who has been permitted to drive the golf buggy) must remain seated in the golf buggy at all times while the vehicle is in motion;
- (f) Drivers of golf buggies must comply with directional signs and not use prohibited areas including public highways and pavements;
- (g) A player who has been granted permission to use a golf buggy (or any caddie or other third party who has been permitted to drive the golf buggy) must accept responsibility for any losses or injury sustained as a result of his or her fault whilst using a golf buggy; and
- (h) A player who has been granted permission to use a golf buggy (or any caddie or other third person who has been permitted to drive the golf buggy) must have adequate personal and third party insurance.
- (i) Where the buggy is hired from a golf facility, the conditions of use of the buggy stipulated by the facility must be complied with.

Failure to agree to the terms and conditions above may result in the player, caddie, or other third party denied permission to use a golf buggy.
