CYGNET TROPHY

TERMS OF THE COMPETITION

1. The competition shall be open to all clubs affiliated to the County Association.
2. Each club shall organise ONE Stableford competition to raise funds for the BCLGA Junior Section. The winning club shall be awarded the BCLGA Cygnet Trophy.
3. An entry fee of £3 per person playing in the competition shall be forwarded to BCLGA as the club entry fee for the competition.
4. The competition shall be held between 1st April and 30th September.
5. The aggregate of the best TWO scores in each of the following handicap divisions shall make up the club scores.

Division 1 Handicap Indices between +5.0 and 13.9

Division 2 Handicap Indices between 14.0 and 25.9

Division 3 Handicap Indices between 26.0 and 54.0

It is the intention that no club should be disadvantaged through lack of enough members in any handicap category. Therefore any club having fewer than 6 members in any of the handicap categories may “borrow” the missing players, up to a maximum of 6 players, as follows:-

Division 1

Borrow sufficient players, up to a maximum of 6 members from division 2, taking the lowest handicaps in that category. Players borrowed to play off their full handicap, but their points count for division 1

Division 2

Borrow sufficient players, up to a maximum of 6 members from division 3, taking the lowest handicaps in that category. Players borrowed to play off their full handicap, but their points count for division 2.

Division 3

Borrow sufficient players, up to a maximum of 6 members from division 2, taking the highest handicaps in that category. Players borrowed to play off their full handicap, but their points count for division 3.

6. Scores should be based on Playing Handicap according to the WHS Rules of Handicapping, ie 95% of Course Handicap.
7. A Trophy to be held for one year shall be presented to the club with the highest aggregate score.
