

Buckinghamshire County Ladies Golf Association CORONATION MEDALS TERMS OF THE COMPETITION

- 1. The County Association shall award annually a Silver Medal and a Bronze Medal to be held for one year.
 - The Medals shall be awarded for a calendar year (1st Jan 31st Dec) and be presented at the BCLGA Annual General Meeting in the following year.
- 2. Each club affiliated to BCLGA may enter one player for the Silver Medal and one player for the Bronze Medal. The same player cannot be entered for both Silver and Bronze Medal competitions.
- 3. There is no entry fee.
- 4. The winner of the Silver Medal will be determined by the lowest scratch aggregate score over 4 rounds over/under the Course Rating of the member's course.
- 5. The winner of the Bronze Medal will be determined by the lowest net aggregate score over 4 rounds over/under the Course Rating of the member's course.
- 6. Rounds eligible for the Coronation Medal are Singles Medal qualifying Competitions played over 18 holes at the affiliated club. Scores in stableford or par/bogey competitions are not eligible.
- 7. Note that this is a separate competition to the England Golf Medal Winner.
- 8. A Medal to be held for one year shall be presented to the player with the lowest aggregate score.
