Summary of Key Points from the BCLGA Executive Meeting May 2019

County Match Week - The team selection was announced and final details discussed.

Gala Day - Friday 26th July at GXGC - Sales of tickets are progressing; some clubs have not yet supported the event at all - details to be passed to Delegates on 5th June

Competitions :

- County Championships the 2019 arrangement of spreading over two weekends was reviewed. The anticipated uptake from working ladies had not materialised in sufficient numbers to make this worth repeating in 2020. The arrangement used by Berkshire of holding the 36 hole qualifying competition on a Thursday and the match-play the following weekend will be tried in 2020 instead.
- All summer knockouts, including Bucks Shield, are going to plan. The third round draw of the Bucks Shield will be held at the June Delegates meeting.
- Entries for the Summer Meeting on 10th July at Harpenden Golf Club and the Seniors/VETS Autumn meeting on 2nd October at Oakland Park have started arriving.

Communications - 512 BCLGA members have opted in so far. Topics for the next Delegates meeting were considered. Purchase of pop-up banners and a small projector have been approved. An additional meeting to review the website had identified some operational matters to take to the developers.

Governance:

- Lynda Hilton has accepted the invitation to be the BCLGA President from Nov 2019
- Phillipa Cook was congratulated on being elected to the Board of Directors of England Golf Susanna Mitterer has offered to stand in as Voting Member representative until the end of 2019. The role will be advertised.
- The role of second team captain will become vacant from Nov 2019, when Janette Psyllides finishes her second term of office
- Noted with regret that Aylesbury Park GC closed as at 31st March 2019
- Grants worth £2500 had been awarded to two applicants, leaving a sum of £2500 for any applications received by August 2019
- Janet Beal, Christine Bishop and Sue Mckeon were congratulated on passing their latest England Golf Rules examinations with excellent scores.
