Summary of Key Points from the BCLGA Executive Meeting March 2019

County Lunch and the Vice-Captain's Meeting - Final arrangements for these events were discussed and agreed.

County Match Week - Detailed planning will start in April.

Gala Day - Friday 26th July at GXGC - The Executive reviewed the proposals by the subcommittee. It was agreed that tickets would go on sale from March 27th.

Finance - The latest financial position was discussed. It was agreed to consolidate the Association's insurance policies, resulting in a reduction in cost with an increase in cover.

Competitions - A significant portion of the meeting was spent considering various competition issues.

- The finals of the Winter foursomes are scheduled for Monday 15th April at Lambourne.
- The Summer leagues start on 17th March.
- Coronation Medal entries have been extended to end March.
- The first round draw for the Bucks Shield has been done; 12 clubs got byes and 8 teams have to play off to get into the last 16.
- The summer knockouts have all been drawn and contestants informed.
- The Summer Meeting is being held on 10th July at Harpenden Golf Club, Hertfordshire. Entries are now being received.
- Venues for the 2020 major competitions are under discussion.

County Championships on May 12th and 18th/19th - Sally Harborne has had a planning meeting with the host club, Burnham Beeches. More entries are required.

Communications - 509 BCLGA members have opted in so far (out of a potential 2800). Topics for the next Delegates meeting were considered. The first Captain's newsletter will be issued shortly, then monthly or as required.

Various governance issues were discussed including Succession planning and England Golf Director nominations.
