2 Competitions Update

- **Summer Meeting** – The details of this have been published and the entries are coming in. At the moment we have only 12 teams entered (Woburn 3, Stoke Park 2, 1 each from Oakland Park, Harewood Downs, Whiteleaf, Lambourne, GX, Denham and one mixed)
- **Charity Eclectic** - We are keen to have as many clubs as possible enter to with entry fees going to Captain's Charities – Work Aid and Thames Valley Air Ambulance

3 England Golf Representative:

Phillipa attended a series of EG meetings at Woodhall Spa on 24th and 25th April - below are the main points from those meetings:

(1). An outline was given on the proposed golf insurance offer to clubs, which will be sent out to clubs – this will be at no cost to the member, it is a benefit of the affiliation fee.

(2). Affiliation Fee for 2020 Affiliation Year.

The EG Board recommended an increase in the affiliation fee for 2020 from £9.00 to £9.50. The reason for this increase was because the Special Projects Fund that has supported the County U14 Talent funding at £223k per year will run out at the end of 2019. The proposal to fund the U14 Talent programme and set the affiliation fee at £9.50 was passed.

(3). At the Annual General Meeting the election took place for two members to the Board of England Golf. Phillipa was one of the two nominations appointed to the Board of Directors.

Following her election to the EG Board, Phillipa is now handing over the EG Representative role to our Seniors' Captain, Susanna Mitterer who has agreed to take over this position in the interim. The post will be advertised for election at the BCLGA Annual Meeting in October. Susanna will be going to the next Voting Members' meeting at Woodhall Spa in September.
