



Dropping Procedure



Drop from knee height.

- Drop one or two club lengths from Reference Point.
 Ball needs to be dropped and come to rest in Relief Area.
- Re-dropped if hits player or object on the way down.
 No re-drop if hits player or object after hitting the ground and remaining in the Relief Area.

Dropping Procedure

 Ball dropped twice and not remaining in Relief Area is then placed.





Rule 7 Ball Search: Finding & Identifying



No penalty if ball moved by player during search.Ball replaced on estimated spot.

- Time to search for a ball reduced to **3 minutes**.
- Balls found outside this period are lost.
 Players can now return and play a Provisional Ball within the 3 minute search period.


Rule 13 Putting Green


- Can repair damage on the putting green caused by person or outside influence.
- Accidental movement of ball or ball marker no longer penalised.
- No longer penalised if holing ball from putting green with flagstick in the hole.
- ${\boldsymbol{\cdot}}$ Ball is holed when any part of it lies beneath the surface




