4 Second tranche of grant applications - Please draw this scheme to the attention of your ladies - deadline for next applications is 1st August 2019.

Two grants were awarded in April to two juniors; total awarded £2500, leaving £2,500 available for future applications. The purpose of the scheme is to support promising female golfers *of any age* to achieve their potential, through the provision of financial assistance where necessary. The maximum total grants awarded in any calendar year will be £5000 and no single applicant may be awarded more than 50% of this total. The Applicant must be a full member of the BCLGA. Application forms are on the website - under Association Business - County Grant scheme.
