

MS Seniors Championship 2022 1 June 2022, Burnham Beeches Golf Club Information for Players



Address and Club Access:

Burnham Beeches Golf Club, Green Ln, Burnham, Slough SL1 8EG

Please note that Green Lane is a single file country lane particularly if you are approaching from the North (M40 Exit at Beaconsfield Services). I would advise to follow the A355 all the way into Farnham Royal and then turning right into Farnham Lane rather than following the SatNav direct route through very narrow lanes and woodlands.

The Gate Code to enter / exit the car park is: 3052

<u>Clubhouse</u>

Please feel free to use the Ladies Locker Rooms (upstairs to the right of the main clubhouse entrance) and enter using code: **3052**

There are 24 guest lockers (key operated) available so I would request that you share lockers with your playing partners or Burnham Club members.

Registration

A registration desk will be set up in the Clubhouse (please do not wear your golf shoes!) from 8:30 onwards. Please report to the registration desk to check in and receive your score card. Tee times are in 8 minute intervals from 9:45 onwards and are in handicap order. Any special local rules will be on the scorecard or communicated to you by the starter. Please arrive at the first tee at least 8 minutes before your allocated start time.

On Course & Practice Facilities

In front of the clubhouse you will find a putting green, two short game areas and two hitting nets. There is also a temporary Driving Range within easy walking distance located between the $1^{st} / 9^{th}$ Fairway and tokens for 40 range balls can be purchased in the Pro Shop for £2.

The Half-way house will not be manned, but there is vending machine (contactless payment accepted) for tea/coffee and soft drinks as well as chocolate bars.

Toilet facilities are also available at the Half-way house and no code is required.

Course Closure

In the event of the course having to be closed due to inclement weather, a klaxon will sound and a message will be circulated to the players.

Flags

A red flag indicates that it is situated on the front portion of the green, a yellow flag indicates that it is situated in the middle section of the green and a white flag indicates that it is situated on the back portion of the green.

Catering on the Day

Tea/Coffee and Pastries will be available for all Players from 8:30 onwards. The kitchen will be open for breakfast should you wish to purchase additional items.

Dinner will be served from 14:30 onwards and is a rolling hot buffet:

- Chicken Casserole (with red wine gravy, onions, celery and carrots)
- Fish Pie (topped with mashed potatoes), Choice of seasonal vegetable
- Vegetarian Option
- Dessert Station with a choice of puddings

Players need not change for lunch but please do note that golf shoes cannot be worn inside the dining room.

The Midlands Seniors Championship Trophy will be awarded to the player recording the best Gross score.
