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| Purpose of post: | To publicise all junior events in the county via various channels, including a regular newsletter. |

Key Tasks

With contributions from other members of the Junior Committee, produce a Junior Newsletter twice a year and circulate to girls, Club Delegates and any other interested parties.

Monitor the County Facebook Group, adding information as needed and ensuring all posts meet published guidelines.

Ensure the safety and welfare of the girls within the County and to raise any concerns regarding a girl's welfare or an adult's behaviour with the County Junior Organiser or County Welfare Officer as appropriate.

The Junior Publicity Officer must:

Read and understand BCLGA Safeguarding Children and Young People Policy and Procedures.

Read and sign BCLGA Code of Conduct for Coaches and Volunteers and agree to always abide by it.

Have good communication skills, especially with young people.

Be computer literate.
