Stage Three Disabled buggy users only	Conditions that, in the opinion of the Course Manager and General Manager, are unfit and/or unsafe for buggy use, or present safety issues to others on the course.	No restrictions	No restrictions	Rental Buggies: Not available. Single seat buggies: Disabled golfers only, are allowed to use a personal ride on buggy. Users must personally undertake a dynamic risk assessment.
Stage Four Course Closed	When the weather or course conditions are such that any use of Buggies is either dangerous or unreasonably damaging to the course.	The course is closed to all Golfers		

Stages 2 to 4 Definitions

Authorised Golfers

Those who can demonstrate that they are unable to play or have undue difficulty in playing golf without the use of a trolley or buggy. This concession is primarily intended for older members and those with a medical condition, which would prevent them from carrying a bag or walking the course. (Authorisation is granted by the General Manager.

Disabled Golfers

Those who can demonstrate that they would be identified as **disabled under section 6 of the Equality Act 2010** and that their disability prevents them from either carrying their clubs or walking around the course. (Authorisation is granted by the General Manager.

Course Closed

Course closed to all Members and Visitors.
