Semi-Final vs. Balcarrick

Cousins Gavin Tiernan and Daniel O'Brien led the way in the semi-final against Balcarrick. They found their rhythm immediately, taking a 2-up lead after three holes. By the turn, they had extended the advantage to 5-up, and play was called in on the 15th with the pair an impressive 7-up, having dropped only a single hole all morning. It was an exemplary, professional performance.

In the second pairing, **Evan Farrell and Harley Phipps** prevailed in a more closely contested match. The opening six holes were halved before they captured the 7th and 8th to go 2-up. Balcarrick responded by winning the 9th and 13th, but Farrell and Phipps regained momentum by taking the 14th. With the pair holding a narrow 1-up lead and the first group already 7-up, play was called. In the challenging foursomes format, both pairings finished the morning at two-under par in their respective matches.

Final vs. Howth

Howth advanced from their semi-final against Malahide, setting up a rematch with a side we narrowly overcame in the opening round of the Senior Cup back in April. After a hard-fought morning, the afternoon line-up and order of play were reshuffled. **Stuart Grehan** was introduced alongside Gavin Tiernan to add further firepower, while Evan Farrell and Harley Phipps led out the opening match. Despite being 1-down through four holes, Farrell and Phipps responded superbly, winning five of the next six holes. They were eventually called in after 14 holes, finishing four-under par for the afternoon. In the second match, Tiernan and Grehan produced a breath-taking display, winning 6-up on the 14th. Despite their opponents making four birdies, the pair recorded an astonishing eight-under par for the 14 holes played. It was an exceptional performance that capped an outstanding day of golf from all five players across both matches.

Over the course of the five game Barton Shield campaign so far, 10 different players have contributed to this success. Four of our five matches have been contested away from home.
