



BUGGY RULES AND INSTRUCTIONS

These conditions apply to both Members and Visitors hiring a Club Buggy

The following rules are to improve standards, ensure safety and preserve the Course

- You must never drive under the influence of drink or drugs.
- No person under the age of 16 is permitted to drive a ride-on buggy.
- All users must hold at least a provisional driving licence.
- Do not move off until all occupants are seated, always remain seated and hold on while the vehicle is in motion
- Hands, Feet and head must be kept inside the buggy at all times while the vehicle is in motion
- The buggy must be used to progress the game and must not be driven up and down excessively, e.g. when looking for golf balls.
- The buggy must not be used on tees, greens or the approaches leading up to them.
- The buggy must not be used within 2 metres of any bunkers, ditches or slopes leading to them.
- Only cross ditches and streams via the bridges and follow the paths where available.
- Check the area behind the buggy before reversing.
- Always consider the terrain, existing vehicular and pedestrian traffic conditions as well as environmental factors that may affect your ability to operate the vehicle safely.
- Drive the buggy only as fast as the terrain and safety considerations allow.
- **Under no circumstances should the buggy descend the hill on the 8th hole back towards the greenkeepers building or the bank between the top and lower plateau whilst descending the 14th hole**
- To avoid tipping over, understand the buggies limitations and the manufacturer's instructions regarding slopes. Drive the buggy straight up and down severe slopes
- Slow down before corners, all turns must be executed at reduced speed. Avoid sudden stops or changes of direction.
- Additional care must be taken when the Course is wet, muddy or has frost on the ground.
- Set the parking brake before leaving the buggy

AFTER USE

- When the vehicle is to be left unattended, engage the parking brake, turn the operating key to the off position and remove the key.
- The vehicle must be immobilised and secured in the designated area at the end of play.
