ADGC Multiple Tee Competitions

On 1st April 2024 significant changes were made to the WHS which included:

• An adjustment to the calculation of Course Handicaps referred to as CR - Par

This change to the WHS Handicap System means that a player who plays to their handicap, on **ANY** course, will now achieve a **Nett** score equivalent to the **Par** of the course or **36 Pts** (Stableford).

Stableford (and Par/Bogey) Competitions

Adjustments for using multiple tees in a competition using **Stableford** (including **Par/Bogey**) are no longer necessary since all players who play to their handicap should now achieve Nett Par or 36 Pts.

Tees Used	Points Difference	Adjustment
White / Red	Difference between 36 and 36 = 0	None
Yellow / Red	Difference between 36 and 36 = 0	None

Strokeplay (including Matchplay formats)

Adjustments for using multiple tees in a competition using **Strokeplay** (including **Matchplay** formats) are now based on the *difference between the Pars of each course.*

Tees Used	Difference in Pars	Adjustment
White / Red	Difference between 71 and 73 = 2	Red + 2
Yellow / Red	Difference between 71 and 73 = 2	Red + 2

Par Adjustments for multiple tee competitions are added to the **Playing Handicap** with All players using their **own card** for **Stroke Indexes** and **Pars** (except Greensomes and Foursomes)
