## Scunthorpe Lions Golf Day 2021 - Format for the day

Today's competition is an Am Am Stableford (best 2 scores count on each hole)

**Playing Handicap:** 85% of Course Handicaps. Maximum Handicap Index: Gents 24.0 / Ladies 32.0 (This is approximately equivalent to the stroke allowances for OLD CONGU handicaps of 28 and 36). (Ladies will play off their own card and will receive 1 shot.). Players with Handicap indexes higher than the maximum may play but will be limited to the maximum Handicap Indexes.

On completing your round members are required to input their scores on any PSI and ALL PLAYERS MUST return their verified and signed card to the box in the entrance hall.

In the event of a tie the Organisers' decision is final.

**Suspension of Play for a dangerous situation** will be signaled by one long blast from the siren...*Players must immediately stop play, mark their ball (if possible) and leave the course immediately.*

**Suspension of play for any other reason** will be signaled by 3 short blasts from the siren. *Players may finish the hole they are on before leaving the course or mark their ball and leave the course immediately.*

**Resumption of play** after suspension will be signaled by 2 short blasts from the siren (repeated). *Players may return to the course and resume play.*
