Handicap & Games



ADGC Multiple Tee Competitions

The WHS Handicap System and Allowances are based on the expectation that a player who plays to their handicap will achieve a **net** score equivalent to the **Course Rating** of the tees used.

Player	Тее	CR (Net Score)	Par	Stableford Pts
Men	White	70.7 (71)	71	36
Men	Yellow	69.6 (70)	71	37
Women	Red	73.2 (73)	73	36

Stableford (and Par/Bogey) Competitions

Adjustments for using multiple tees in a competition using **Stableford** (including **Par/Bogey**) are based on the *difference between the points* achieved when playing to handicap.

Tees Used	Points Difference	Adjustment
White / Red	Difference between 36 and 36 = 0	None
Yellow / Red	Difference between 37 and 36 = 1	Red + 1

Strokeplay (including Matchplay formats)

Adjustments for using multiple tees in a competition using **Strokeplay** (including **Matchplay** formats) are based on the *difference between the net scores* (*CR*) achieved when playing to handicap.

Tees Used	CR Difference	Adjustment
White / Red	Difference between 70.7 and 73.2 = 2.5	Red + 2.5
Yellow / Red	Difference between 69.6 and 73.2 = 3.6	Red + 3.6

Adjustments for multiple tee competitions are added after allowances and before rounding !

All players use their **own card** for **Stroke Indexes** and **Pars** (except Greensomes and Foursomes)
