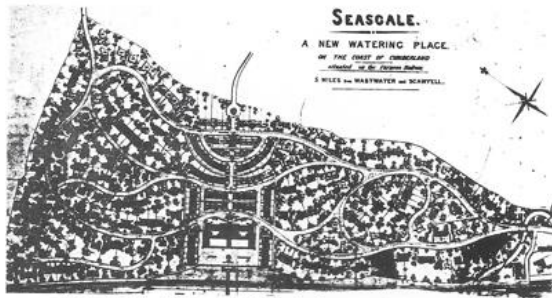


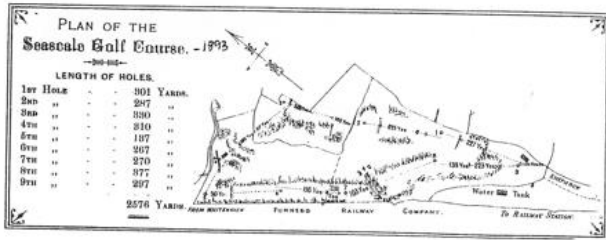


## **It's All History Now**

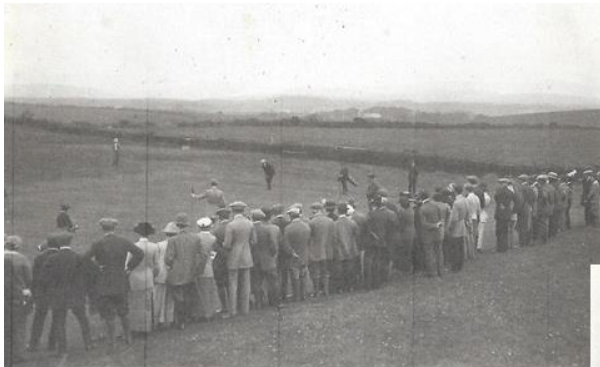
## CADDIE REGULATIONS

1. The Club is in no way responsible for the engagement or payment of Caddies.
2. On **WEEK-DAYS**:
  - (a) Caddies over 16 years of age will be engaged and paid direct by Members and Visitors, the charge being 1/6 per round and a fee of 2d to the Caddie Master.
  - (b) Caddies under 16 years of age will be engaged through the Caddie Master at the following rates:---
 

1st Class	--	1/6 per round
2nd do.	--	1/3 do.
- On **SUNDAYS**:
 

The charge for Caddies will be 2/4 for all grades, together with a fee of 2d. to the Caddie Master.
3. The Caddie Master's fee is a return for his services in maintaining order and discipline amongst the Caddies and assisting players in engaging and paying them.

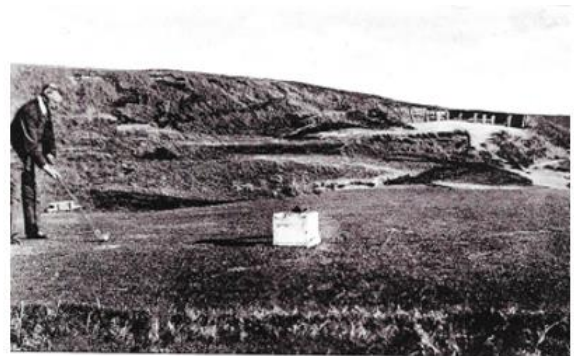

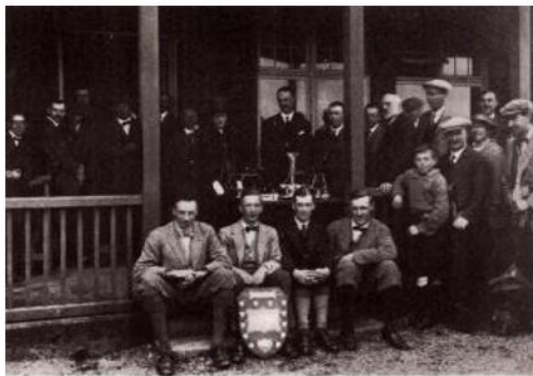

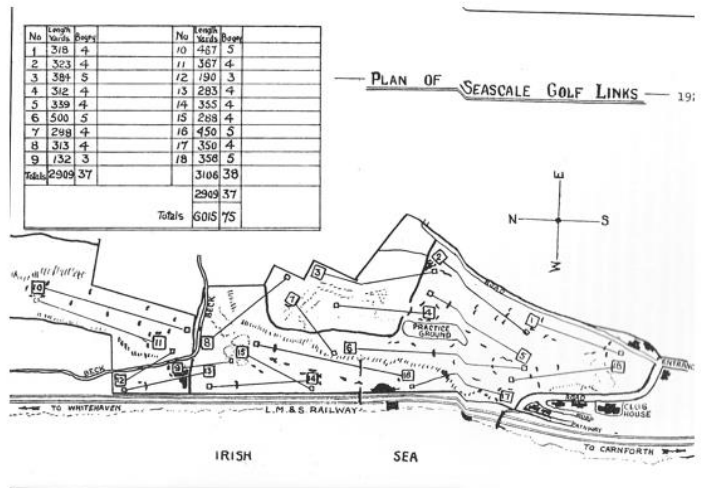
