Dress Code

DRESS CODE WHEN PLAYING ON THE COURSE

- All golf shirts made to the designs sold specifically for golf
- All shirts must be tucked in, unless purposefully designed to be worn outside
- Appropriately styled tailored shorts and skirts are permitted – **tailored means with belt loops and fly, no outside or baggy pockets**
- Socks worn with shorts must be accessorized or be predominantly white
- Shoes sold specifically for golf must be worn (Under 12's attending the academy and caddies or non-playing guests may wear trainers on the course)
- Weather protection wear made to the designs sold specifically for golf

NOT ACCEPTABLE WHEN PLAYING ON THE COURSE

- Tracksuits
- Rugby, Football or T-shirts
- Beach shorts
- Denim trousers or shorts
- Please do not roll long socks down if worn with shorts
- Please do not tuck trousers into socks

DRESS CODE IN THE CLUBHOUSE

- At all times the dress standard shall be smart golf wear or SMART casual attire unless otherwise stated
- Shirts tucked in, unless specifically purchased to be worn outside
- Plain trousers of smart denim and of uniform colour are acceptable – **No stains, fraying, slits, metal attachments or logos apart from the manufacturers will be allowed**
- Dress rules for Social Occasions will be advised by the organiser(s)
- Footwear must be worn in the Clubhouse
- Soft spikes are allowed in the 19th Bar if the weather is dry
- **Golf shoes should not be worn in the lounge or restaurant areas of the Clubhouse**
- **No shorts allowed at evening functions**

NOT ACCEPTABLE IN THE CLUBHOUSE

- Beach shoes or Crocs
- Tracksuits
- Weather protection wear
- Wet or soiled clothing
- Caps

SOCIETIES TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. These conditions apply for the booking of any golf day at Selby Golf Club
2. Golfing Standard - It is expected that all visiting groups ensure that all their members play to a competent standard (guideline of maximum handicap for men of 28 and ladies 36). Although we do not expect all players to hold an official handicap, we expect them to play to a reasonable standard to enjoy their day, and not spoil the golf for others. Each player must have their own golf clubs and bag, golf footwear and is expected to know, and carry out, the normal etiquette of golf.
3. Reservations – Provisional and Confirmed - Reservations will be regarded as provisional until such time as a signed copy of the booking form and the required deposit has been received by the Club. The Club reserves the right to release a provisional booking in the absence of receipt of these items.
4. Deposits / Payment Terms - On initial booking of golf day a deposit of £100 is required to secure the booking. If not received, the Club reserves the right to take an alternative booking for this day. 2 weeks prior to golf day Selby Golf Club to be informed of minimum numbers expected.
5. 48 Hours before the golf day, final numbers for catering and golf must be advised, and full payment made. Any reduction after this time will be subject to catering being charged in full. Prior to departure on the day, the organiser must pay all charges in full.
6. Final Golf Requirements - 14 days prior to the golf day the organiser should provide final information such as arrival times, programme of events including mealtimes, and special requirements, such as buggies, nearest the pin and longest drive.
7. Dress Code - All golf societies must comply with the current dress regulations for the Club. The Club reserves the right to refuse to allow access to the course or clubhouse those who are improperly dressed.
8. Course Etiquette - All golfers are requested to observe course etiquette – players must rake all bunkers after use, replace divots and repair pitch marks on the greens. Trolleys and buggies must not be taken onto the aprons to greens or onto tees. Please bring these points to the attention of all of your group.
9. Slow Play - We would expect most groups to complete a round in around 4 hours. Anything over this will spoil the enjoyment for your players and those behind them. Please select a format for your day that will ensure that this is achievable.
10. Liability – Selby Golf Club cannot accept any liability for any damage, to other persons by visiting players whilst on the Club's property including damage arising out of negligence. All players in your party should be notified that they enter onto the golf course or into the club's premises at their own risk, and consent to the risk of loss, damage or injury howsoever caused. Selby Golf Club can accept no responsibility for the loss of, or damage to property when left in public areas, or cars parked in the car park.
11. Food and Drink Brought onto the Premises - No food or drink is to be brought into the Club by clients hiring the Club facilities.
12. This does not include bottles brought in as prizes for golf days that will not be consumed on the premises.
13. Food Disclaimer- In accepting these terms, the client acknowledges that Selby Golf Club cannot accept any liability for any food taken off the premises.
14. Cancellation by Selby Golf Club. The Club reserves the right to cancel or amend any reservation:
 - If the Club, or any part of it, is closed due to fire, natural disaster, employee dispute, alteration, demolition, decoration or by order of any public authority.
 - If the client becomes insolvent or enters liquidation or receivership
 - If the client is more than 30 days in arrears with any payment due to the Club
 - If the reservation is found to be potentially detrimental to the reputation of the Club
 - If inclement weather prevents the playing of golf. In this event the club will refund any deposit made in respect of the booking, but will have no further liability to the client



Staying Safe Playing Golf- Visitors

The following guidelines are to ensure the safety of everybody. Please comply fully with them.

- Due to track and trace requirements, please complete the attached contact form with **all** players names and telephone numbers and return via email before your visit.
- No changing facilities or showers are currently available.
- Toilet facilities are available at the halfway house, visitor toilets are available for Ladies in the front entrance and Gents toilets can be accessed in the 19th.
- Visitors should arrive for their booked tee time no more than 15 minutes in advance and be near the 1st tee no more than 5 minutes before the pre booked time.
- Please try to park in alternate spaces in the Car Park whenever possible and change into your golf attire.
- There will be a one-way system in operation from the Car Park to the first tee and from the 18th green to the Car Park. Please follow the arrows
- Play will commence from the first tee only. Please **DO NOT** tee off before your allocated time.
- No scorecards are available at the present time
- Wherever possible, please carry a mobile phone. Dial 999 in the case of emergency.
- There should be no physical contact, including handshakes, with anyone at the Club at any time.
- Maintain social distancing at all times both on and off the Course
- If possible, please take hand sanitiser with you onto the course and use it frequently.
- All ball washers, waste bins, shoe cleaners and course furniture will have been removed or will be out of action. There will be no drinking fountains open on the course, please take your own refreshments.
- Rakes will be removed from bunkers. Visitors should endeavour to “smooth” the sand with a foot or a club when leaving the bunker. If a player feels that he/she has a bad lie due to lack of rakes within a bunker then the ball can be lifted and placed in the sand.
- Only handle your own golfing equipment.
- Only putt with the flagstick in. The flagstick should not be touched.
- The hole will be a shallow cup for easy retrieval of balls.

- There will only be one teeing area on most tees to be used by all players although on certain holes there will be a forward tee for use by Ladies.
- Play should, at all times, be continuous, so If a ball is lost **do not go back** to play another.
- Do not touch or pick up balls lost by others.
- On completion of your round please go directly to the Car Park from the 9th or 18th green, via the one-way system.
- Finally, load your equipment into your car, please change your shoes if you wish to use the Clubhouse .
- If you wish to use the bar and catering facilities please enter through the front entrance and wait to be seated, a table will be allocated for you to enjoy food & refreshments for up to 90 minutes. Your order will be taken at your table, please do not queue at the bar.
- Please use the dispenser in the foyer to sanitise your hands before entering the Clubhouse.
- If possible, for safety purposes please pay for food and drink using a contactless card there are no cash facilities at the bar
- It is imperative that for the safety of all our members and visitors the above guidelines are observed. It is possible that a visitor failing to comply with any of the above could result in them being asked to leave the premises.

Failure to adhere to the above could also ultimately cause our golf course to be closed
