Entry Fees: As defined by Council from time to time

Juniors with a minimum of five years membership pay no entry fee when transferring to full playing membership. Juniors with less than five years continuous membership will pay the full entry fee reduced by 20% for every full and complete year as a junior member.

Members who resign, and wish to be reinstated as a member, will be expected to pay the entrance fee. Members wishing to transfer from Country to Full Playing membership will be expected to pay the difference between the relevant entry fees. *Reduced subscriptions*

- Playing members qualify for reduced subscriptions from age 65, subject to their having completed 20 years continuous 7 day Full playing membership of the Club.
- Further reduced subscriptions are available from age 70 subject to their having completed 25 years continuous 7 day Full playing membership of the Club.

Payment of Subscriptions

- 1. Subscriptions must be paid by 31st March.
- 2. Bankers Order Forms will not be accepted after the 31st March.
- 3. Members who have not paid their subscriptions by the end of March or submitted Banker Order Forms will not be allowed to use the club and course facilities from the 1st April and will be considered for expulsion from the Club at the next meeting of the Council.

Election of New Members

1. Membership of the club is open to anyone interested in golf on application regardless of sex, age, disability, ethnicity, nationality, sexual orientation, gender reassignment, religious or other beliefs.

Subscriptions will be kept at levels that will not pose a significant obstacle to people participating. Arrangements will be made to ensure people on low incomes can fully participate in the Club's Activities.

- 2. Each application for membership shall be in writing containing the name, address and occupation of the applicant.
- 3. The Administration Manager shall send the name and address to each member of Council.
- 4. Council will hold an election which will be decided by majority vote

Membership

Membership is a minimum 12 month commitment, renewable each year in April for a minimum of 12 months. Members may join during a given year and then membership is renewable in April for a minimum of 12 months. Please Note that this does not apply to Lifestyle Membership, Play More Golf Membership, Emergency Services Membership and Community Membership.

Transfers

Members transferring membership status during the year will be expected to pay the relevant fee for each period of membership. The transfer will be subject to Council authorisation.

Resignation

Any member may resign from the Club by giving notice in writing addressed to the Administration Manager before 31st March of the current year. Resignations after this date will require payment of full subscription for the year. Please note this does not apply to Lifestyle, Play More Golf & Affiliate Membership.

Please Note: If you wish to pay by instalments, then you are agreeing to pay the full years subscriptions even if you cease to play at WEGC during the year.

Requests for reduction of subscriptions on medical grounds In common with many other English Golf clubs, it is Club policy not to allow reductions in subscriptions for periods of playing inactivity on medical grounds. The Club advises members to consider golf insurance policies which are available and may provide subscription protection.

Country Member

Any person who is not ordinarily resident within a radius of 50 miles of the Clubhouse shall be eligible for Country Membership, providing that person is a full 7 day playing member of a private golf club.

Visitors Regulations

1. No visitor may be signed in for the purpose of playing golf with a member at the discretionary rate more than six times a year.

PLAYING AND COMPETITION REGULATIONS

- 1. Members are reminded that our main competitions start in April. Members will NOT be able to play on the Course until they have paid their subscriptions.
- 2. Social members are allowed to play the course on six occasions during the current year on payment of a Green Fee at the rate equivalent to playing with a Playing Member. They are eligible to use the practice facilities.
- 3. Country members are not entitled to compete in Major Competitions (except Open Competitions). Similar to the list for Lifestyle Members.
- 4. All members must have returned at least six qualifying scores in the preceding twelve months to be eligible to compete in Board Competitions unless prevented from so doing by illness or injury.
- 5. Other than the Annual Medal Final, Male Juniors are not eligible to compete in Club Board Competitions unless they have a playing handicap of 16 or less.
- 6. In any Men's competition where there are eleven competitors or less there shall only be one division.
- 7. Ladies playing in Board Competitions must comply with the Ladies Section Rules.
- 8. Matches starting at any tee other than the First Tee and matches where players do not intend to complete a full round have no standing and should give way to players overtaking them and playing a full round.
- 9. Members are not permitted to practice on any part of the course other than the Practice Area, Practice Net and the Practice Putting Green, unless as part of a lesson with the Club Professionals.
- 10. Members are not allowed to play in greater than four balls unless they receive permission from the Professional.
- 11. Ties in competitions
 - Stroke play (18 holes):- In the event of a tie, decisions will be made on the last 9 holes, if still a tie decisions are made in the order of the last 6, 3, 2 or 1. Appropriate handicap allowance to be deducted.
 - Stroke play (36 holes):- In the event of a tie, decisions will be made on the last 18 holes, if still a tie decisions are made in the order of the last 9, 6, 3, 2 or 1. Appropriate handicap allowance to be deducted.

The award to be made on the last 18 holes, if still a tie decision will be made in the order of the last 9, 6, 3, 2 or 1 of the last 18 holes. Appropriate handicap allowance to be deducted. Match play: Ties after 18 or 36 holes are to be decided by a 'sudden death play off'. Handicap Allowances to be taken as 1st Round.

12. In the event of a disagreement the matter must be referred to the Handicap Chair or designated Committee member, whose decision will be final.

CLUBHOUSE REGULATIONS

Opening Hours

• The Clubhouse will be open from 7am in the summer and 8am in winter, closing at 11.30pm when necessary on Saturdays and weekdays and at 9pm on Sundays. The Council shall have the powers to amend these hours and any amendments will be posted on a notice in the bar and the main notice-board.

Licensing Hours

• The current permitted licensing hours are from 10.00am to 11.00pm Monday to Thursday when necessary, 10.00am to 12.30am Friday & Saturday, when necessary and from 11am to 10.30pm on Sundays. The Council shall have the powers to amend bar opening times within the permitted hours and any amendments will be posted on a notice in the bar and on the main notice-board.

Junior Members

- Members under the age of 18 years are not permitted to purchase alcohol from the Bar or consume alcohol in the Club.
- Members under the age of 16 years must be accompanied by an adult in the Bar Area when the Bar is open.

GENERAL REGULATIONS

- The Council has power to alter or amend Rules and Regulations.
- Alterations or amendments to the Memorandum and Articles of Association may only be made by a Special Resolution at an AGM or other General Meeting.
- Complaints should made in writing to the Administration Manager who shall bring such complaints before the Council. The Council's decision will be final.
- No paper, notice or placard, written or printed, may be placed or exhibited in the Clubhouse other than those authorised by the Administration Manager.
- Dogs are not allowed in the Clubhouse or on the course, with the exception of Guide Dogs.

RULES AND ETIQUETTE

Pace of play:

In the interests of all members, golfers should:

- Play at a good pace
- On completion of a hole leave the green without delay
- Should keep up with the group in front.
- Players searching for a ball should allow the following match to play through and, having waved a group through, must not continue to play until the group has passed and are out of range.

Please refer to Section 1 of the current edition of Rules of Golf "Etiquette; Behaviour on the Course" Particular attention is drawn to the last paragraph, Conclusion; Penalties for Breach.

Care of the Course:

- Bunkers should be raked carefully to remove marks made by clubs and golf shoes.
- Divots should be replaced and secured
- Pitch marks made by approach shots to the green should be identified and repaired as soon as possible.
- Players should be careful not to damage the greens with either their clubs or the flagstick and should avoid standing or walking close to the hole when tending or replacing the flag.

Practice:

Whilst practicing on the course is not allowed it is permissible to play balls from the practice ground onto the 16th fairway if:

- No competition is in progress.
- Priority is given to members playing the course.
- A maximum of **20 clearly marked** balls are used.
- Only one member may practice onto the 16th fairway at any time.

Priority when starting a round and on the course must be given to Club matches. Members should not play from the first tee 15 minutes prior to the above starting times and/or 15 minutes after the above times. Under no circumstances should any team match be held up.

SAFETY RULES & REGULATIONS

Safety Rules

- 1. In the event of an Electric Storm a klaxon will be sounded and players must suspend play immediately and leave the course.
- 2. Golfers must not tee off unless the Club's criteria for playing in fog are met. Players who have teed off must retire from the course if one blast on the klaxon is heard.
- 3. Players are reminded that it is their own responsibility to suspend play & safely leave the course under their own initiative should they consider the weather conditions represent a danger to themselves and / or other people.
- 4. Golfers are advised that the course and artificial surfaces may be slippery and must check and ensure to wear the appropriate footwear to meet the conditions prevailing on the Course at all times.
- 5. Golfers must report all Accidents / Dangerous occurrences which happen on the Golf Course during play to the Professional or the Administration Manager. Golfers MUST report any balls they hit out of the boundary walls of the course to the Pro Shop at the end of the round. If the Pro Shop is closed leave a message behind the Bar for them.
- 6. All Buggy users must use the pathways provided or remain on the designated route (route detailed on Buggy) at all times.
- 7. Greens staff working on the course must be given priority at all times and must not be approached whilst any machinery / equipment is in operation.
- 8. Golfers are advised to report any medical conditions they may have or medication being taken to the Committee and playing partners prior to the commencement of their round.
- 9. Where steps are provided for entering or leaving a green they must be used, and not the grass banks.
- Players must be aware of vertical drops in front of the 10th and 12th greens and the back of 1st and 13th tees.
- 11. Players need to be aware of the priority and trolley parking rules when the extended 16th tee is in play.
- 12. Players are prohibited from wearing or the use of MP3 / CD players or other device with earphones whilst on the course or practice area.

For information:

- A. First Aid assistance and equipment is available within the Greens Workshop and Club House. First Aid Personnel are the Green Keeper and the Professional
- B. The Club defibrillator machine is located outside the front entrance to the Club House A second defibrillator is located outside the Greenkeepers Shed.
- The current list of trained personnel can be found adjacent to the defibrillator machines.C. For evacuation purposes the Emergency Assembly Point is located in the Main Car Park.
- D. Golfers must always be aware of other golfers on the course and especially aware of flying golf balls.

Golfers should follow set procedure and golf etiquette.

E. Due to the problem of vandalism Golfers are asked to be aware and alert to unauthorised persons on the golf course. Mobile phones may be used to inform the Professional or Administration Manager of any unauthorised persons on the course.
