On Arrival

Woodsome Hall Golf Club is situated to the south of Huddersfield and close to the main motorway networks. Our full address (including postcode for Sat Nav purposes) is Fenay Bridge, Huddersfield, HD8 0LQ. We have security gates at the entrance, which are generally open. However if the gates are closed press the call button on the right hand side of the stone column and we will open the gates. Please drive slowly when coming and be aware that golfers may be playing the 18th on the right-hand side. At the end of the drive, you will see a large sign with directional arrows indicating the locations of our various amenities.

Our visitor car park is situated on the far side of the Clubhouse, take care as you pass because golfers may be teeing off on the 1st to your right.

On arrival please register with the Professional's Shop which can be found on the cobbled area to the right at the end of the drive. You will be directed to one of the 2 entrances to the Clubhouse. There are gents & ladies changing rooms with showering and toilet facilities and visitors changing areas with lockers for you to use if required, payable by a refundable £1 coin.



Course Information

Described by the late Peter Allis as “*A hidden gem of a course*” Woodsome Hall provides traditional quality golfing values to members and visitors alike. With a Par of 70 and a SSS of 71 the course is an excellent test of skill for golfers of all levels with accuracy and thought being the key to success.

Practice Areas

We have 2 separate practice areas, one for chipping and short play and, one general range for using all clubs. The Practice Putting Green is situated next to the 1st Tee. Machine Tokens for buckets of practice balls are available from the Pro’s Shop (or if closed from the Bar in the Clubhouse). Buckets of balls cost £2.50 for 20 or £4 for 40.

Buggies & Trolleys

If you require buggies or trolleys, advance notification will be required as they are in high demand during our spring and summer months. Buggies are taken out of action during the winter months. Trolleys with winter wheels can be used during this time.

Dress Code

At Woodsome Hall, the Dress Code has long been a way of ensuring everybody entering the club, member or visitor, on the Course or in the Clubhouse, can feel confident and relaxed, knowing they share a common and accepted standard.

The general principle is that you should look smart, and that your clothing and footwear is clean and dry in our clubhouse areas. The full details of our dress code policy can be found on the website in the golf section but here are a few requirements.

On the Course

Smart golf clothing worn in the appropriate manner, with golf footwear only – no sports trainers. T Shirts, Team Sport Shirts, tracksuits, beachwear, denim jeans, shorts, joggers, cargo or combat trousers are not permitted.

In the Clubhouse

Clean dry golf attire. Smart Casual clothing including smart denim or chino jeans is acceptable. Tailored shorts, deck shoes and moccasins can be worn. Flip flops or outdoor golfing shoes with ribs or spikes are not allowed.

Dormy House Stays

The Club has a magnificent 8 twin bedroomed Dormy situated at the rear of the 7th green. All rooms have en-suite facilities with wi fi, TV, tea & coffee making facilities and modern tasteful decor. Check-in is available from 3pm to 7pm. If you have made a booking please could you advise us of the approximate time of your arrival. The keys to your room can be collected from the Clubhouse Bar. If you have booked a breakfast this will be served in the Clubhouse. The same dress code rules apply as mentioned above. For emergencies only contact 07947 724840.
